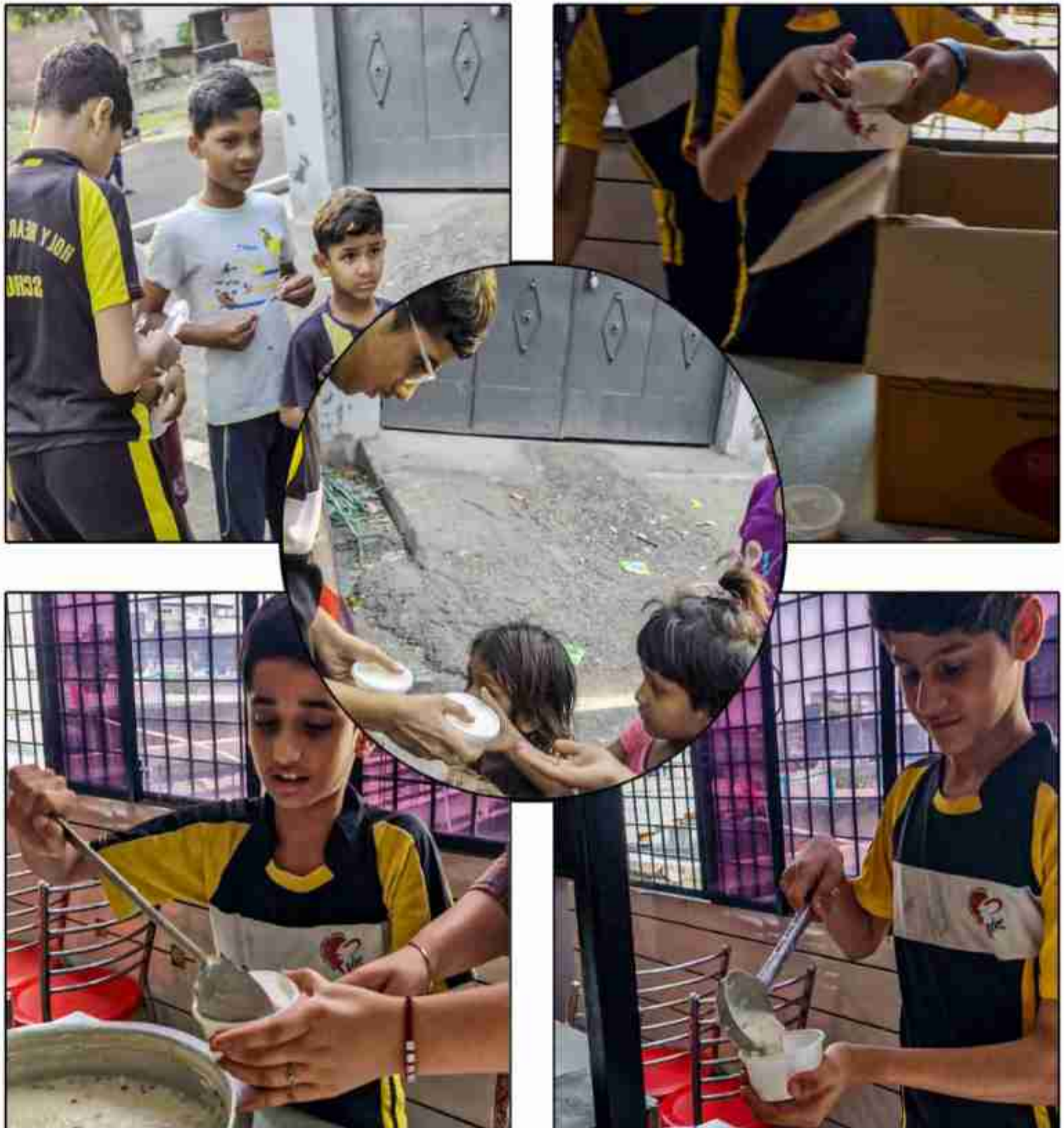

Events like these not only provide a platform to showcase their talent but also encourage independence, build confidence, and promote meaningful community engagement.

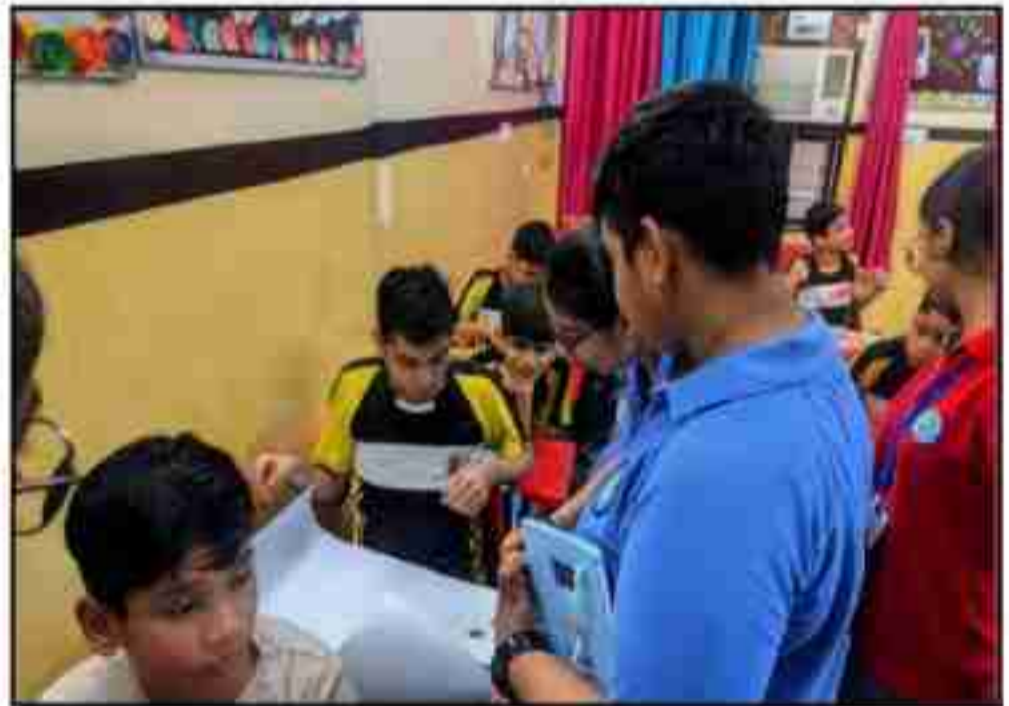
