1. SPECIAL EDUCATION:

Holy Heart Special School focus on the educational program, emotional awakening and outcomes for the student with intellectual, physical, hearing, speech-language impairment, autism spectrum disorder or multiple impairments.

- Our school provide a climate that is a psychologically, inclusive space where all students understand one another better and feel safe. We deal with all age level student.
- First, we assess the child for 2-3 weeks and focus on functional, educational and ADL depending on the case and its severity. Then we plan the activities for the child according to the age group.
- We make an individual educational plan for the child according to the case and severity. IEP plan is for 3 or 4 months, in which we take the goals that we want the child to learn. We use different teaching techniques- like if the child is educable, we work on the academic part and vice versa.
- We help the children to differentiate and generalize the things through educational aids like real objects, flashcards, storytelling activities etc.
- We provide an environment for art and craft activities and nourish the skills of children.
- After achieving the goals, we prepare the achievements reports, conduct the parent-teacher meeting and discuss the plan ahead.
- A highly qualified special educator with an advanced degree, help children to face and overcome challenges.
- We do workshops and conduct counselling sessions regularly, and keep the parents and caregivers informed.

2. EARLY INTERVENTION:

Early intervention focuses on assisting children in learning the necessary skills that typically develop during the first three years of life, such as:

- Physical (reaching, rolling, crawling, and walking)
- Cognitive (thinking, learning, solving problems)
- Communication (talking, listening, understanding)
- Social/emotional (playing, feeling secure and happy)
- Self-help (eating, dressing)

Early intervention services can help children learn many vital skills and catch-up in their development phase

- A program that provides therapy and educational support services
- Equips children with necessary skills and helps develop their potential
- Early intervention is a therapy and educational support service that allows special needs children with functional expertise, e.g. fine/gross motor, cognitive, communication, social and self-help skills for learning and living
- We recognize the child's learning needs and provide intervention for their development growth in a naturalistic and interactive learning environment
- We use a playful approach to make children learn certain concepts, e.g. blocks, puzzles, beading, sorting etc.
- We involve children in music, dance and art to develop their skills in those fields and improve social skills like sharing and caring for one another.

3. SPEECH THERAPY:

Speech therapy techniques help to improve communication. These include articulation therapy, language intervention activities, and others depending on the type of speech or language disorder.

Articulation, Fluency, Resonance, Receptive, Expressive, Cognitive-communication are various speech disorders that can be corrected or improved by regular sessions of speech therapy.

The approach used varies depending on the disorder. It may include physical exercise to strengthen the muscles used in speech (oral-motor work) speech drills to improve clarity or sound, or loudness and production practice to improve articulations and language parameters.

We here at Holy Heart Special School deal with all types of special needs children for speech or language problems.

- We assess the child and provide individual therapy plans
- We take children with ASD, Down's syndrome, CP, MR, ADHD, and Muscular dystrophy, HI, LD and Aphasia
- We use the latest techniques developed for a particular disability
- We plan different activities for children, e.g. to teach blowing we use paper blow, and candle blow then progress to the spirometer
- We start with the base to achieve every milestone until we accomplish a skilled performance
- We are focused on fun learning approach with the help of activities
- In the early intervention group, we give more focus on fun learning techniques
- In older children, we categorize students as per their interests and abilities
- We focus on one-to-one learning
- Group communication in a playful approach to improving social interaction is useful

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Occupational therapy is a health and rehabilitation profession.



4. OCCUPATIONAL/PHYSIO THERAPY:

Holy Heart Special School entertains children of all age groups with impairments such as Cerebral Palsy, Down syndrome, Autism, ADHD, Muscular Dystrophy etc. Skilled therapists provide physiotherapy and Occupational therapy for children. Therapists undertake a wide range of activities to ensure quality service to students.

- We provide services in a planned manner.
- We first assess the students' physical and functional needs.
- We design a therapy program which focuses on the requirements of a particular age group.
- We give reviews at regular intervals.
- We work on muscle power, range of motion, balance, posture, sensory and behavioral problems using the latest techniques.
- We focus on one-to-one sessions as well as group activities to enhance learning.
- We give generalized as well as individualistic care to our children.
- We work on improving the fine motor, gross motor and ADL skills to do his/her daily routine activities.
- We encourage and motivate students to actively take part in the therapy sessions, providing them with a warm and caring environment.
- We assess, prescribe and review the aids and equipment's required by the students.
- We hold consultation and counselling sessions for parents.

5. VOCATIONAL TRAINING:

Vocational training provides students with a curriculum that equips them for the job that they expect to join. Broad-based knowledge and skills are good, but for some students with disabilities, specific skills need to be explicitly taught that are necessary for survival in the workplace and the community.

When developing customized vocational service for students with special needs, Holy Heart Special Schools focuses on:

- Individual needs and abilities
- Independent living skill development
- Personal interests and goals

Pre-vocational skills for students with disabilities include:

- Time management
- Problem-solving
- Critical thinking
- Personal hygiene and appearance
- Responsibility and integrity
- Attitude and demeanour

Vocational skills examples include:

- Work readiness
- Interview and job search skills
- Social and communication skills
- Task analysis
- Career choice
- Safety

Holy Heart Special School helps students prepare for independence in private and work lives by providing vocational and pre-vocational programs. The school provides students with opportunities to work while learning. These opportunities expand their experiences and give positive experiences by working as skilled professionals. The activities help students achieve their goals such as performance, exploration and communication, as outlined in their individualized education plan (IEP).

1. BOYS HOSTEL:

We completely understand that living away from home in a new surrounding is a daunting responsibility for any child and accommodating to the new surroundings might not be an easy job for them. The ambience enclosing the hostel is one of pure youthfulness and innocence, with special-needs students from all corners of India coming together to stay under one roof. The hostel truly is a home away from home in every sense leaving no stone unturned by furnishing them with the best care and facilities.

A hostel is a shelter for students who reach from distant places. Students live there with each other and learn the importance of discipline and teamwork. Hostel life brings a sense of responsibility to become self-dependent in life. We administer excellent hostel amenities, instilled with love and affection.

Our hostel rooms are spacious, neat and tidy. All the modern facilities and comforts help in making the hostel environment accommodating for our hostellers. 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

2. SPORTS TRAINING:

Holy Heart Special School provides sports facilities to encourage physical fitness and offer recreational activities for the children.

Sports can help in managing weight, a common problem among kids nowadays.

3. TRANSPORTATION

Holy Heart Special School provides transportation facilities for the students to benefit for special education. Parents are advised to avail of school transport only. Transportation includes travel to and from school. Teachers accompany the little ones to ensure their care and safety. We have made it a point to follow all regulations applicable to school vehicles.

The school employs only experienced drivers and conducts regular orientation programmes on the guidelines laid by the school authorities for students' safety.

4. COMPUTER CLASSES:

Students are provided facilities in Activities of Daily Living, Therapies according to their requirement, and Recreational activities where they socialize with others. We work on enhancing their functional skills & coping with their challenging behaviour. At the same time, the daycare program also functions as a break for the parents. **Presently we have implemented special education to a few students with Special educators, helpers, Occupational & Speech therapists in an air-conditioned classroom.**





The teachers instruct on musical instruments such as the keyboard, piano, guitar, drums, etc.




